Moseley Architects Wins “People’s Choice Award” for Providence Middle School Design

November 23, 2020 – Moseley Architects’ work on Providence Middle School in Chesterfield County Public Schools won the firm the “People’s Choice Award” at the 2020 Virginia School Boards Association’s *Exhibition of School Architecture*, which took place in conjunction with the association’s Annual Convention which was held virtually this year.
