#### Wednesday, November 15

Liz Huntley Bio - Liz is a committed child advocate and passionate litigation attorney who practices law at <u>Lightfoot, Franklin &</u> <u>White, LLC</u> in Birmingham, Alabama. On a regular basis she serves as a motivational speaker throughout the country and shares her inspirational story of an Alabama woman who overcame nightmarish events and tremendous adversity during her childhood to become a successful attorney, motivational speaker, and member of the Auburn University Board of Trustees.

Dr. David Jeck Bio - Dr. Jeck served as the Fauquier County Public Schools Superintendent. He spent the previous five years as the superintendent of Greene County Public Schools. His career in education has included time as a coach, teacher, assistant principal, principal, and assistant superintendent for instruction.

During his ten years as Fauquier's superintendent, the school division achieved record-high graduation rates. Dr. Jeck has spent the past two years writing his book aimed at helping school leaders stand up for teachers. The book is called "Courageous School Leadership".



## VSBA 5K Run/Walk





### VSBA Recognition Awards

#### **VSBA Board of Distinction**

The VSBA seeks to identify school boards that will be designated as a VSBA Board of Distinction. Boards must apply for the designation and must meet specific requirements in four key areas: planning, policy, promotion, and board development. If eligible, the board will receive a plaque to hang on the wall of their boardroom designating the board as a VSBA Board of Distinction. Designation as a VSBA Board of Distinction may be accomplished by the chair, with the approval of the board, completing and returning the checklist and supporting materials by July 21, 2023. Once a school board has achieved this designation, it may reapply after two years for continued VSBA Board of Distinction status. The announcement of the recipients and presentation of award plaques will be made during the VSBA Annual Convention in November.

#### **VSBA Regional School Board Member of the Year**

The VSBA seeks to recognize one outstanding school board member from each of the nine VSBA regions who exemplifies local involvement in promoting student achievement. Nominees must be, or have been, a board member serving on a VSBA member school board within the preceding 12 months ending June 30, 2023. Local school boards may establish the process by which they identify candidates for nomination. The VSBA panel of judges will accept one nomination from each school board, and that nomination must be based on a discussion by and unanimous vote of the school board. The announcement of the winners and presentation of award plaques will be made during the VSBA Annual Convention in November.
