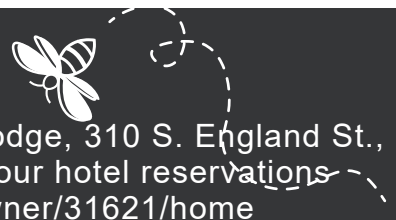
ABOUT FACILITATOR: LORI GRANT
